Helsinki Biennale 2008 is a World Fair. Secretly we have built pavillions and other good mood totem poles typical for world fairs in the cellar of Design Museum. Participating we have more than 50 most interesting artists from Finland and over 100 of our favorite artists from abroad.

Helsinki Biennale is an independent art organisation based on collaboration between different artists. It operates on the border zone of art and design. Helsinki Biennale brings together interesting artists and builds up a platform to create new without a commercial goal or predetermined forms. This creates new ideas, interfaces, forms of co-operation and activity, working methods, and "good stuff".

Helsinki Biennale was first time arranged in 2006 at Myymälä2 Gallery. This second time the attitude will remain the same, even though the crib is finer this year. We will continue working with a do it yourself attitude learned from streets, garages, and cellars. Helsinki Biennale 2008 is this year also curated and coordinated by Aki-Pekka Sinikoski.
